- 3. Communications i.e. news, leaflets, posters, feedback, website updates (5mins)
  - Newsletters include the next 6 weeks' worth of dates and published once a month, it was raised as to if anyone uses these so we shall investigate adding some web analytics to monitor this
  - Website & Leaflet Content has been refreshed and both brought in line with each other
  - Poster still pending
  - Club Feedback still pending to create feedback area on the website. We shall also aim to collect feedback at the quarterly meetings via posticks notes.
- 4. Finances Interim Budget / Cash flow (5mins)
  - Our Horsell indoor sessions roughly broke even on costs
  - We are still down on session fees overall in comparison to previous years
  - We are in the process of investing in some new kit (see section 7)
  - The club are also looking to invest some money into encouraging more individual paddler progression, help towards FSRTs and securing spaces on some L1 / L2 courses (see section 8)
  - We are looking to also book Lee Valley for Sept
  - We still have a couple of outstanding invoices to settle but have still got some reserve funds
  - Dulverton gave us a full refund after the Barle confusion last year

- 5. Fees inc. Membership, Session & Equipment Hire (10mins)

- 6. Equipment Repairs, Maintenance, Bids for new (15mins)
  - Equipment Inventory The club completed a full inventory back last years and since then Owen and Richard have drafted equipment proposals and we have started to replace and repair kit
    - General Club Decks
    - General Fixtures and Fitting to Repair Boats
    - Polo PDFs
    - Polo Competition Paddles of Varying Lengths
    - Polo Large Helmets to replace broken ones
    - Polo Decks for the Composite Boats
  - It was proposed to look at the number of children's paddles
  - It was also raised that one or more boats require welding
  - We are looking to do a full shed sort out ahead of the lido season on the 17<sup>th</sup> April. If you are available to

- 7. Coaching, Courses & Club Development (15mins)
  - Reiterated that the 'Development Plan' is where individuals can find out what the club aims are, what the club supports and is currently the means to find out about club funding / help. It was also mentioned that if there was anything anyone wishes to put forwards onto the development plan this can be done via the coaching officer <a href="mailto:coaching@bvcc.org.uk">coaching@bvcc.org.uk</a>. The latest version is published on the website on our documents section <a href="mailto:www.bvcc.org.uk/documents/">www.bvcc.org.uk/documents/</a>.
  - Polo reviewed sections to include some new aims and objectives in regards to increasing participation, facility improvements and networking with the wider polo community.
  - A new section was added to the development plan to "encourage more independent paddler progression routes" this shall be done through:
    - supporting members to utilise the Facebook Group to do more independent paddling or setting up their own events
    - encourage engagement in the wider paddling community via external events which shall be periodically added on the calendar
    - encouraging initiative to improve own skills, helping towards costs of Lee Valley Paddler Progression Programs. Individuals can request approval for this in advance of attending the course by emailing their proposal to <u>info@bvcc.org.uk</u> and if approved, on completion of the course could be refunded up to 1/3 the costs (as per agreed when approved)
  - Still investigating running a SUP trip/course/module, email communications have gone out, just waiting on a response to get a final date, the day trip arranged shall cover the costs and this shall not be subsidised
  - The club have secured 6 spaces on a L1 course in September and 3 spaces on a L2 course in October to encourage development of more coaches
- 8. Session Arrangements (10mins)
  - It was raised that if we were to change the night to Tue/Thu at this would impact
    - coaches that also help with local scouts, guides etc.
    - youth that also attend these groups
    - o options of when we can run group taster sessions
  - With Wednesdays already booked, it was agreed that we would book every Tuesday, offering these for the scouts with Thu by special arrangement only
  - It was also agreed that whenever there isn't a scout sessions run we would offer the night as a 'members' only night subject to coaching availability
  - When there are enough to help out with scouts, the coaches can also opt to use the Tuesdays alongside the scouts for either just themselves or for small focus groups such as for those on courses again this is strictly for use by members only (this shall hopefully increase the overall numbers on both Tuesdays and Wednesdays)
  - We require to investigate winter options for September/October to report back investigations asap with the aim to book something before the Lido season starts
  - Polo's last Alton session is the first week in May
  - Polo sessions through the summer shall be running their regularly night on a Tuesday with a beginner's session on the first Wednesday of every month at the Lido for the main club, they have also offered to do their best to help out with the occasional scout's session should there be any booked in on a Thursday
  - The first Lido session back is in 'Go Canoeing' week, we are going to offer out this as a free event split into 2 x 40mins sessions
- 9. Event Arrangements (10mins)
  - It was requested that we try and get trip sign ups out earlier than we currently do irrespective of the dates being set and that reminders are send out
  - Everyone was also reminded that we do give out a 6 weeks' itinerary in EVERY monthly newsletter

- Reminder that the club are supporting the Family Camp again this year on the 23<sup>rd</sup> April and should anyone like to get involved to contact Bob Hamilton or Bridget Keogh
- We have been looking at the 30<sup>th</sup> Birthday Celebrations and BBQ, we need to contact the lido to find out when the first weekend availability as a possibility for an 'end of the summer season' celebrations
- We have already set up a marathon taster session, we are also looking at setting up a slalom taster session
